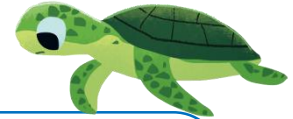

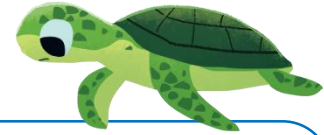

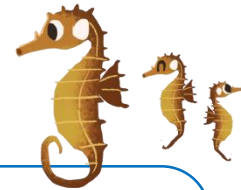

Deep Ocean  
Current

Formed by a great disturbance in the ocean

Rip Current

The movement of a large body of water in a certain direction, this direction may change or stay the same over time.



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
